## **SUPPORT SB 524 & SB 422**

## SB 524: AUTHORED BY SEN. MELTON

- A bill to strengthen renter protections and address the eviction crisis in our state by:
- Allowing tenants to withhold rent and/or repair and deduct payments for severe habitability violations that go unaddressed
- Expanding legal aid to tenants in crisis
- Sealing eviction filings
  when there is no court
  judgement and providing a
  process for expungement
  for good cause shown,
  allowing families to secure
  new housing
- Limiting security deposits to one month's rent
- Making it a criminal offense to rent a condemned property
- Increasing the notice for rent increases from 30 to 60 days

## SB 422: AUTHORED BY SEN. BOHACEK

- A bill that provides common sense clarity in landlord-tenant law to:
- Allow tenants to terminate lease if basic habitability standards are not met or repaired within reasonable time frame of moving in
- Basic habitability in the bill includes functioning sanitary systems, heating or air conditioning, plumbing, electrical systems
- The bill also cleans up state code to ensure the eviction notice requirement applies to all rental leases, not just informal or oral leases
